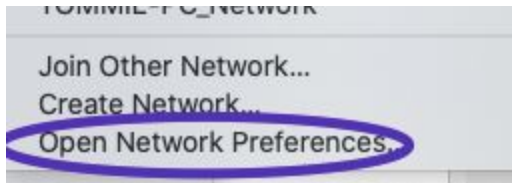


To remove a wireless network from your Apple computer, you can do the following.

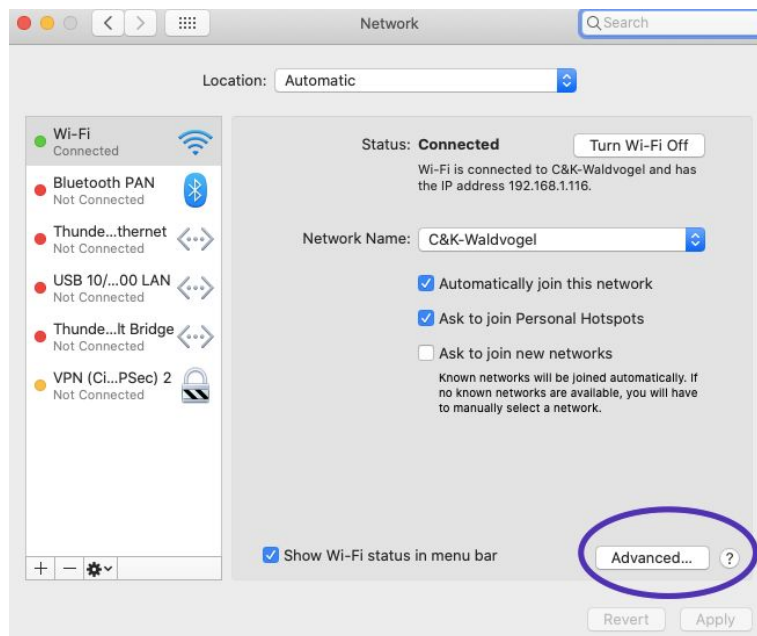
1. Click on the wireless network icon on the top left of the computer.



2. At the bottom of the drop-down menu click Open Network Preferences



3. Click Advanced in the lower right side

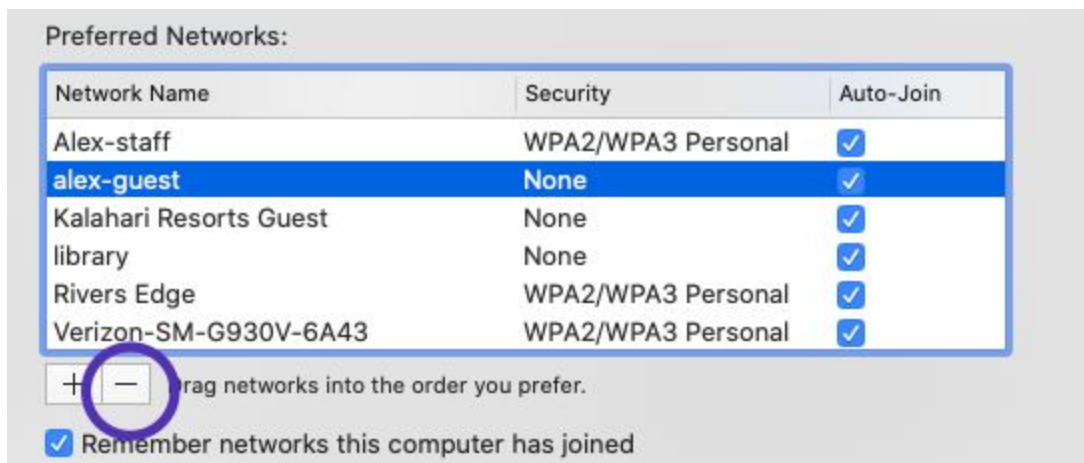


4. Find the District Guest network and click on it.
